4 Easy Ways to Request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot

From the Sarasota Supervisor of Elections

CALL 941.861.8618 and be prepared to provide your name, address, date of birth and address where the ballot should be mailed.

EMAIL votebymail@sarasotavotes.com with the same information.

SUBMIT an [online request](#) for a Vote-by-Mail ballot.

PRINT the [Vote-by-Mail Ballot Request Form](#) and mail it in. *Snowbirds: Best option if you're requesting your ballot be mailed to an alternate address.*

Plan ahead. Do it today.

The deadline to sign up for Vote-by-Mail is October 24 at 5:00 p.m.

Every Vote Matters!

If the election is within 7 days, to ensure your ballot is received on time, do not mail it in. Instead, complete your ballot and drop it off at a secure box at one of the early voting sites during early voting dates and times published at [SarasotaVotes.com](https://www.SarasotaVotes.com) or at Elections Offices in Sarasota, Venice or North Port.



Why register to vote-by-mail?

- Vote from the safety and comfort of your home.
- Vote in advance, whenever it's convenient.
- Avoid crowds and skip the long lines at the polls.
- It's free and easy to sign up.

If I register to vote-by-mail, does that mean I can't vote at the polls?

No, you still have the option of early voting or voting at your local precinct on election day. Just bring your vote-by-mail ballot to the polls with you so you can turn it in.
