Make sure you get your ballot on time!

Dear Linda,

The most important election of our lifetimes is almost here, and Vote-by-Mail ballots will be mailed out starting September 24.

The Post Office cannot hold your ballot, and they cannot forward it to you. However, the Supervisor of Elections can send it to you at an address different from where you live. Check your address with them now to be sure they send it to where you will be able to receive it.



Take these simple steps to check your address online:

- Go to www.sarasotavotes.com/votbymail
- Enter your name and date of birth
- Verify that the address shown for the November 3 General election (at the bottom of the page) is the one to which you want your ballot sent. If it isn't, call the Supervisor of Elections office IMMEDIATELY to give your correct address.
- Call [941-861-8618](tel:941-861-8618) (weekdays 8:30am – 5pm).

Do this today to make sure you receive your ballot without delay!

When you receive your ballot, VOTE! Fill it out and send it back promptly. Don't wait to the last minute. It must be **received** by the Supervisor of Elections – not just postmarked – by November 3rd.
