## There are several ways to request a vote-by-mail ballot:

1. **Call 941.861.8618** and be prepared to give your name, address, date of birth and address where the ballot should be mailed. Pursuant to Florida law, a request for

a ballot to be mailed to an address other than the one on file with the SOE, must be in writing and signed by the voter. (Exception: absent uniformed service and overseas voters)

- 2. Send an e-mail request to <u>votebymail@sarasotavotes.com</u> with the same information.
- 3. **Submit an <u>online request</u>** for a vote-by-mail ballot.
