Hispanic Radio Ad Campaign on Numero Uno in Sarasota and Manatee Counties unveiled by Mica Glasberg, Hispanic Caucus President and SCDP Vice Chair. Fantastic strategic plan for ongoing informational campaign on Spanish language radio. Multiple scripts, carefully sequenced leading up to Nov. 8. Ads, and a monthly 1/2 hour show called "Today is a Good Day for Democracy". The shows will address the housing crisis, misinformation, wages, and immigration. The cost is \$300 per show. Ads: 332 30-second ads in north Sarasota County and Manatee County and 295 ads in South County.

And...

- ✓ Be sure to *Customize* in the first text box— Your brief greeting, with names of PCs and contact info
- ✓ Take out content that is not relevant—like elections and candidates that your voters can't vote for. Know your districts. Add stuff that is happening in your precinct.
- *Resend* your newsletter a couple days later to non-openers—it's easy: Download the MailChimp phone app from your App store. View the Campaign in Reports. Scroll to the bottom of screen and hold down Resend. You can only Resend once. It goes to people who did not open the first time.



I, ______, having been duly sworn, say that I am a member of the Democratic Party, that I am a qualified elector of ______ County, Florida; that during my term of office, I will not support the election of the opponent of any Democratic nominee, I will not oppose the election of any Democratic nominee, <u>nor will I support any non-Democrat against a Democrat in any election other than in judicial races;</u> that I am qualified under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida and the Charter and Bylaws of the Florida Democratic Party to hold the office I am seeking, or to which I have been elected; that I have not violated any of the laws of the State of Florida relating to election or the Charter and Bylaws of the Florida Democratic Party.
