Recruiting Volunteers Develop



Have a document/card/letter similar to "Volunteer Today" (see attached)

Make multiple copies to hand out at Meet and Greets, drop in Lit bags, attach to emails, and post on your precinct FB or website.



Have a prepared script either planned or memorized when asking people to volunteer?

"Are you happy with the current representation? The environment? Want to make a difference? Are you a "techie"?



Make sure that the Precinct list of Dems is up to date.

Ask the Data team for an updated list at any time.



Always include Newly Registered voters....this comes out once per month! (see attached).



MailChimp email to send out to all Precinct Dems and ask for volunteers.

□ Provide transport drive volunteers around neighborhoods, pick up & drop off materials, and transport voters to & from the polls on Election Day.
☐ Hosta coffee or cocktail hour for neighbors & friends. Wine and cheese pairs well with Democratic political activism!
Participate in the Neighbor-to-Neighbor Program by contacting an assigned group of people three times before November. (We provide training, contact lists, and scripts.)
□ Participate in door-to-door chats & literature drop-off. We provide training, lists, & scripts, & we will walk together.
☐ Help Katie and Maureen develop winning grass-roots strategies.
☐ Write Letters to the Editor.
☐ Develop an email newsletter or manage our social media network.
☐ Make Get-Out-&-Vote phone calls from your home or our office. (We provide lists and a scripts.)
☐ Help prepare mailers from your home, our home, or our office.

Recruiting Volunteers Request



Get a list of all known volunteers in your precinct.

This is available with all their contact information and what jobs they have volunteered for.



Get a list of all know Dems in your precinct that are members of a Club or Caucus.

If they already joined a Club or Caucus, they are more likely to help in the precinct.



All this information is available from the Data Team.

Recruiting Volunteers Ask 1



Remember to keep it simple. Just reach out and ask! Put yourself out there!

Keep in mind, that 1 out of every 4 people say they don't volunteer because they haven't been asked.



Have a prepared script either planned or memorized when asking people to volunteer.

"Are you happy with the current representation? The environment? Want to make a difference? Are you a "techie"?



Make sure that the Precinct list of Dems is up to date.

Ask the Data team for an updated list at any time.



Always include Newly Registered voters....this comes out once per month!



MailChimp email to send out to all Precinct Dems and ask for volunteers

No job is too big or too small.

Recruiting Volunteers Ask 1.1



Utilize personal connections.

Area Precinct Captains, friendly neighbors, friends in clubs, caucus, local connections (garden club, book club)



Grab a list of all Dems in your precinct.

Send a MailChimp email and ask for help or send a personal email to known volunteers in your precinct, clubs/caucus



Area Meet and Greet- Area 4 tentatively 2/12/22 at Naar Hall 2-4pm

Will ask for volunteers for ALL precincts (more to come)



Precinct Meet and Greet or Precinct Happy Hour

#321 1st Happy Hour had 4 attendees, now we get over 100 at a Happy Hour



Publix Parking Lot-a Treasure Chest

Look for Left leaning bumper stickers, introduce yourself, and ask them to get involved.

Easy conversation starter and then they know how to contact you!

Retaining Volunteers Form relationships with your Volunteers



This is a face to face thing.

Emails/phone calls are great for initial contact, but to build a team, have a conversation in person.



Get to know your volunteers.

Where are they from?



Have they been involved in politics prior? Which campaigns?

What do they enjoy doing?



"Tell me about your prior life...what did you do professionally".

Look for special skills....especially ones you need (technology, outreach, writing).



Always empathize with how they are feeling and continue to be upbeat! Encouragement!



Ensure that the volunteers know you appreciate them through thank you calls, notes, and even a volunteer get together. #321 had a Holiday party to just say thank you.



Keep volunteers informed of any training that they would enjoy.



Remind them we ARE making a difference

Let them know their work is valued and appreciated!
